



A beneficial web

Draw a bird's eye view of your garden. Map the crop and the flowers that have been added to the garden bed. Draw lines between the crop and the flowers and write down the beneficial links you have planned. These lines may criss-cross and create a web.

Benefits could include:

- Pollinators fertilising the crop
- Predators protecting crops from pest insects.
